## Geliefde oudinwoner en besigheidsman oorlede



Van Zyl was 'n geliefde persoon in hierdie omgewing en het ook diep spore getrap as besigheidsman.

Petrus Abel Johannes Louw van Zyl is op 3 Desember 1959 te Graafwater gebore en het in 1977 aan Hoëskool Vredendal gematrikuleer. Hy was maar 7 jaar oud toe sy pa by Pep begin werk het en vakansietye het hy ook daar werkies soos pamphletverspreiding gedoen.

Van Zyl begin in 1979 self by Pep werk, waar hy 'n indrukwekkende 40 jaar diens gelewer het. Later jare is hy aflosbestuurder in Springbok-area tot in die noorde van Namibië. In 1981 is hy aangestel as winkelbestuurder in Springbok en in 1988 kry hy bevordering tot voorraadkontroleerder. In 1989 is hy bevorder tot areabestuurder in die Karoo.



In 1990 verhuis die gesin na Lutzville waar hulle 19 jaar gebly het. Al drie kinders het daar hul skoolloopbaan voltooi.

In 2007 het hy weer bevordering gekry na die Weskus as areabestuurder en later risiko-bestuurder. In September 2019 na 40 jaar diens tree Van Zyl af.

Vele van sy oudkollegas onthou hom as 'n baie goede leermeester en allemansvriend

Op skool het hy uitgeblink in rugby as heelagter en ook atletiek met paalspring. Later jare het hy vir WP weermag rugby gespeel en kon glo met albei voete skop.

Hy het gedien as voorsitter van Lutzville Rugbyklub en verder was hy die grootste aanhanger van sy kinders teen die sportveld

Sy vrou Elzabe, kinders Sarita, Elmarie en FK sal hom onthou vir sy humor, liefde, omgee en bereidwilligheid om almal te help. Wat hy aangepak het, het hy met erns en met trots aangepak - hy was 'n mense mens. As hy jou 'n drukkie gegee het, het jy gevoel dit word met liefde gegee. Sy geloof en liefde vir sy Hemelse Vader was baie duidelik. Hy was 'n voorbeeld vir baie en sy voorbeeld sal deur sy familie en vriende uitgeleef word om sy nagedagtenis te koester.

Die plaas is vir 'n rukkie, nadat inligting ontvang is, gemonitor om die beweging van "kopers" dop te hou.

Die lede het beslag gelê op 613 sakkies en 2 groot sakke met los dagga. Die los dagga het 5.36kg geweeg. 'n Groot bedrag geld is ook gekonfiseer. Twee mans is gearresteer vir Handel in Dagga.

Die lede het ook 'n operasie op 'n naburige plaas gedoen om die onwettige

handel in drank aan te spreek.

Die Citrusdal GPF ondersteun die fokus op dwelmhandelaars. Hul bedank adjudantoffisier Geuystry van die honde eenheid en Vermeulen van Mountain Men vir hul ondersteuning tydens die operasies. Dwelmhandelaars doen wat hul doen om geld te maak.

## Modified Namakwa Sands East OFS Project Residue Disposal Plan: Release of the Draft Scoping Report for Public Review

Tronox Mineral Sands (Pty) (Ltd) (Tronox) mines heavy mineral sands at the existing Namakwa Sands Mine at Brand se Baai. Tronox is authorised to mine and process the deeper Orange Feldspathic Sand (OFS) resource underlying the currently mined material at the East Mine (known as the EOFS Project). For the EOFS Project to proceed, Tronox must modify the approved residue disposal plan (this project): this includes a single RSF to accommodate all fine residue from the project, two large Sand Tailings Facilities (STFs) (sand tailings stockpiles) and other infrastructure.

Tronox require a Waste Management Licence (WML) in terms of the National Environmental Management: Waste Act 59 of 2008 (NEM:WA), Environmental Authorisation (EA) in terms of the National Environmental Management Act 107 of 1998 (NEMA), a Water Use Authorisation in terms of the National Water Act 36 of 1998 (NWA) and an amendment to their approved Environmental Management Programme Reports (EMPr) in terms of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act 28 of 2002 (MPRDA) in order to allow for the project. SRK Consulting (South Africa) Pty Ltd (SRK) has been appointed to undertake the required Scoping and Environmental Impact Reporting (S&EIR, also referred to as EIA) process required to inform these applications.
