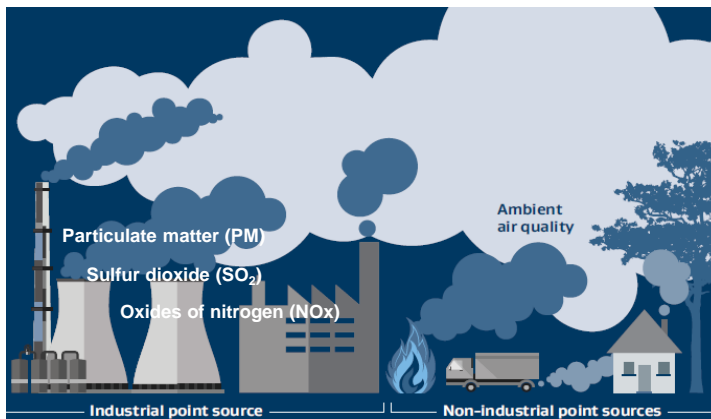

▶ Natref continues to implement projects to advance its air quality improvement roadmap

- Installation of secondary roof seals on floating roof tanks (1996-2004). The primary and secondary roof seals help to prevent the escape of volatile organic compounds (VOC) from the tank roof
- A vapour recovery unit (VRU) was commissioned for handling vapours from rail and road loading
- Natref also upgraded and installed low-NOx burners at its Diesel Hydrotreater heaters to reduce NOx emissions (2005 and 2006)

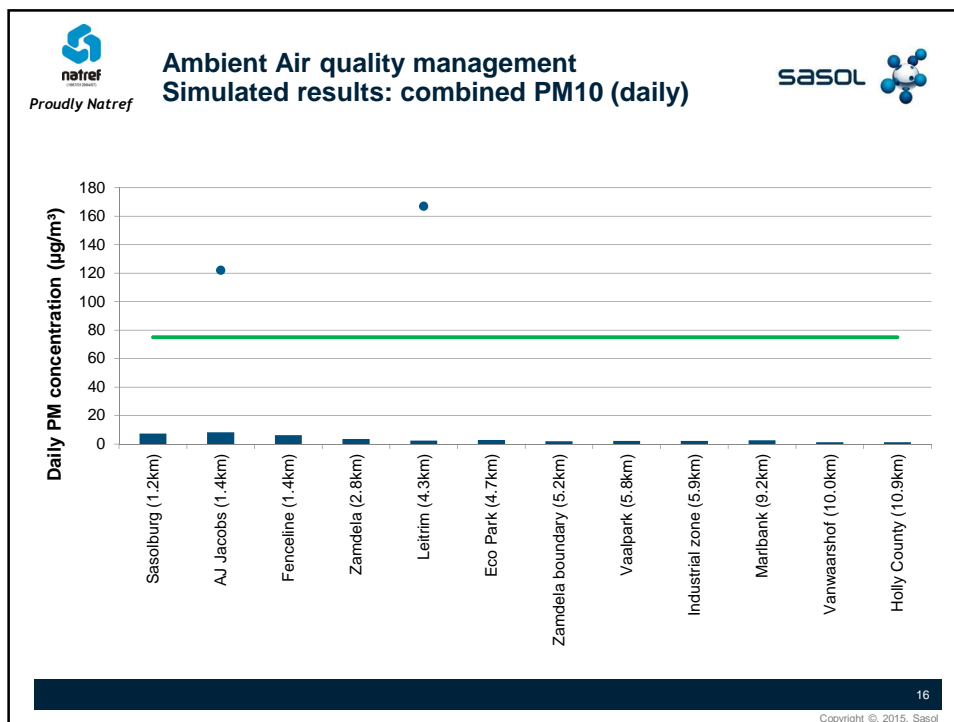
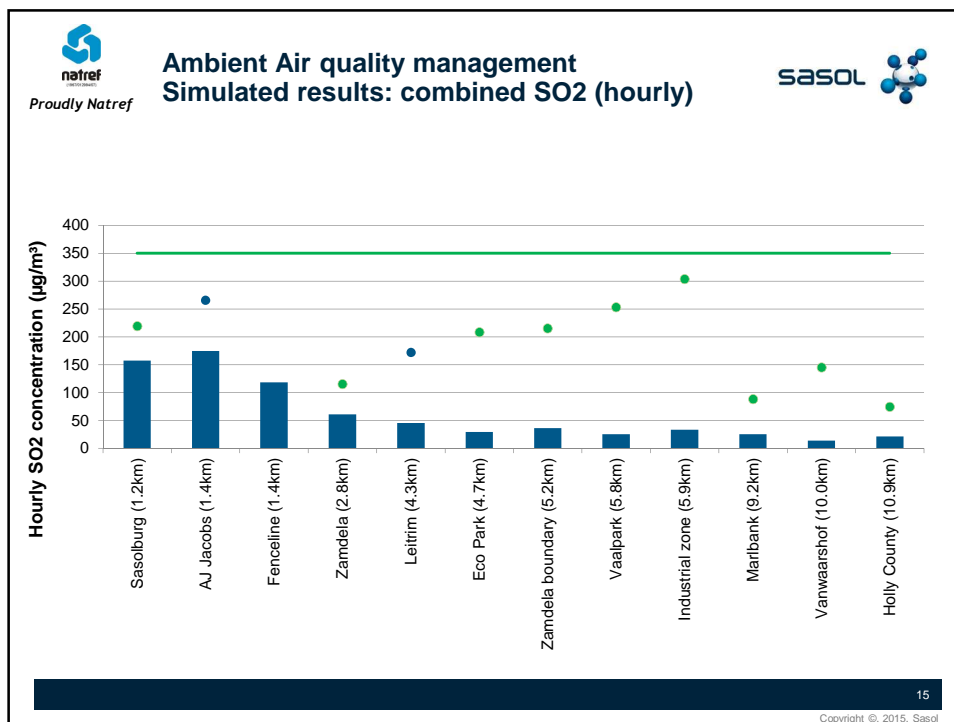
Ambient Air quality management Current state of ambient air quality – SO₂

Air Quality improvement roadmap Sasolburg Operations and Natref

- Sasol boiler precipitator upgrades to improve the efficiency of particulate matter removal from the boiler stacks
- Sasol is investigating further technology and retrofitting options for PM, SOX and NOX improvements
- Natref will be replacing the existing Fluidized Catalytic Cracker cyclone separators in late 2016, followed by abatement technology with appropriate performance to reduce particulate matter emissions
- Natref is currently investigating the construction of a second Sulphur Recovery Unit to increase its availability to 99%
- Natref plans to install floating devices in storage tanks to prevent VOC emissions
- In addition to the above mentioned interventions related to own emission sources, Sasol and Natref will be implementing ambient air quality improvement interventions (offsets) in the community subject to this public participation process

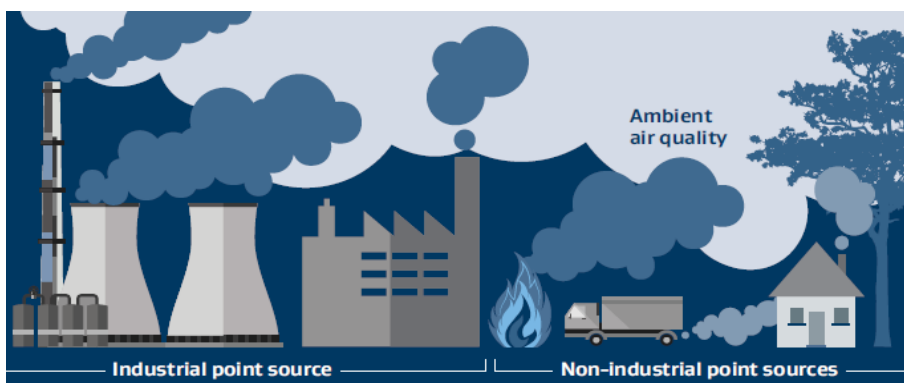

"An intervention, or interventions, specifically implemented to counterbalance the adverse environmental impact of atmospheric emissions in order to deliver a net ambient air quality benefit within the affected airshed/s. Wherein 'affected airshed' means the closest area to a section 21 facility where ambient air quality standards are being or have the potential to be exceeded and opportunities for offsetting exist."
